He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and was a Director and past President of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology. Dr. Tyndall is currently the Councilor for Scientific Affairs and Public Policy of the Executive Council of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology.

Dr. Tyndall is a Professor in the Department of Diagnostic Sciences and General Dentistry at the UNC School of Dentistry. He received his DDS in 1980 from the UNC School of Dentistry, his MSPH in Radiological Hygiene and Medical Physics from the UNC School of Public Health in 1984, and his PhD in Health Physics and Radiation Biology from UNC in 1988.
